Dressage – Test & Train Friday 8th December 2017

Pick- A- Test & Request A Time Slot on entry form or when phoning to enter. (2.45pm – 8pm)

After warming up you will **ride your chosen test** as in a normal dressage competition. The BD judge will score you as normal and your sheet will be available for you to take home with you.

Upon completing the test – **the BD judge will come and talk through the test** and give advice on how more marks could have been gained. A **qualified trainer will then go through some of the movements** with you to help put that advice into practice. You will then **ride the test again** which will be marked and again that score sheet will be available for you to take home.

Rosette to all competitors who improve on their 2nd test.

Relaxed & informal, No competition wear or plaiting, washing etc unless you want to. Appropriate Hat & footwear compulsory & tack for horses/ponies as per BD rules.
